Historically, every single patient on AirView had the same compliance rule. Now you have the ability to select different **Payors** per patient. This allows for greater flexibility in managing your patient population.

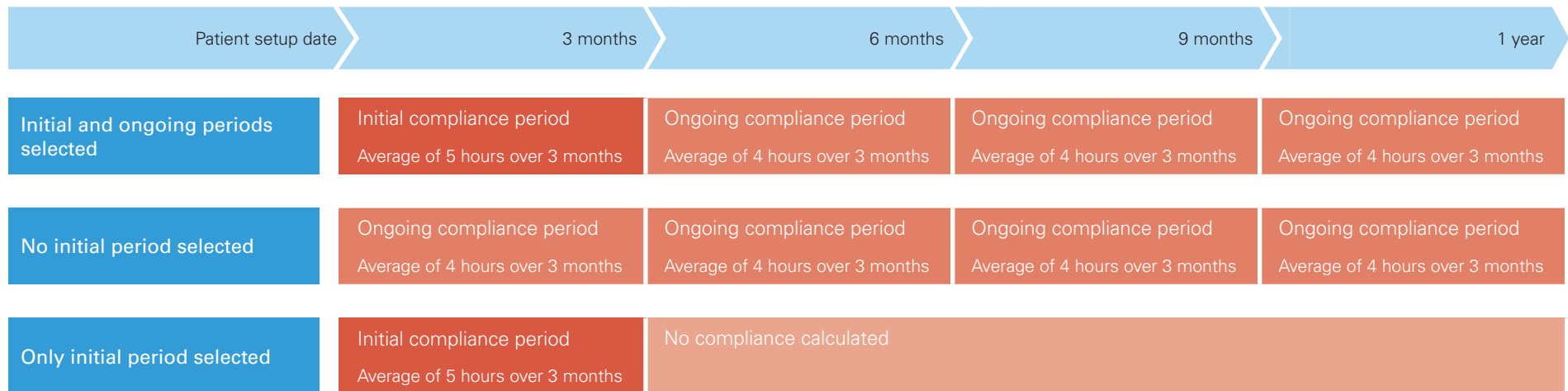
Your AirView administrator can create custom **Payors** defined by compliance rules from a preset list. The **Payor** can then be assigned to patients individually. An initial and ongoing compliance period can also be defined.

What is initial and ongoing compliance?

Initial compliance starts from the patient setup date and will be their first period. This is useful if you want to track patients to a different standard in their early stages of therapy.

Ongoing compliance is repeated for periods after their initial compliance period. If no initial compliance is chosen, their first period will be their ongoing compliance period.

Setting up initial and ongoing compliance

After selecting a payor template, you can set the initial and ongoing compliance periods from a preset list. You can also set the current selections as the default for all new patients.
